- High quality wreaths made of Canadian Balsam and hand made with pine cones and ribbon for decoration.
- **Payment must be collected at time of sale.**
- Checks made out to Troop 188.
- Please wear Class A while selling.
- Wreaths will be delivered to customers on the weekend of December 3rd.
- There is the Boone camp out that same weekend but due to this being a holiday item we have to get them disbursed as quickly as possible. Delivery on Sunday December 4th would be ideal.
- Each item you sell will bring a significant amount of money back to the troop. PLC decided to move forth with a variety of fundraisers including this one as there is a need for the money.
- Many of the items will bring a 50% profit to the troop.
- For example, our cost on a 24" wreath is \$7.37 and we are selling them for \$14.
- 8.5 x 11" posters can be created and hung at work. Dennis Powers will scan the poster and send it out to everyone.
- Churches may be a source for selling.
- The quality of the product will sell itself in following years should we do this again.
